1. Please request permission first.
2. Please clearly credit the author and the website (Texas Deafblind Project) as well as the URL (www.txdeafblindproject.org). If the author is not specified, please credit Texas Deafblind Project Staff.
3. Please summarize the article in your own words and add a link to the original article, rather than copying and pasting the original article in its entirety.

4. If you are interested in posting a full article, please contact us to discuss the options. We love to be invited to write guest posts on other websites or blogs!

Reprinting in Newsletters or Other Publications

1. Please request permission first by emailing Kate Borg, TSBVI Outreach Director, at borgk@tsbvi.edu.
2. Please clearly credit the author and the website (Texas Deafblind Project) as well as the URL (www.txdeafblindproject.org). If the author is not specified, please credit Texas Deafblind Project Staff.
3. If your publication appears online, including in .pdf format, please follow the guidelines above for posting on the web.

2. If they are part of a specific post or article, they may be copied for print handouts needed for educational purposes only in limited quantities. **Images may not be copied for use on another website.**
