Intervener Role for Supporting Educational Access

Interveners support their DeafBlind student's concept, communication, social and emotional development.

Interveners seek for and grab opportunities for expanded learning.

Interveners maximize incidental learning opportunities since they do not happen often for DeafBlind students.

Interveners respond to students' actions.

Interveners allow students to work through challenges and know when to offer support or guidance.

Interveners are the eyes and ears of the student who is DeafBlind, informing them of people, places, things and activities in their environment and facilitating connections and participation as needed.

Interveners not only work in schools; they work in the home/community.
